Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Northeast Community College. Students must receive a grade of "C-" or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

All courses are also offered at Clarkson College and are not necessary for admission.
