Service Contract Member Benefits

Service Contract Members who meet the eligibility criteria will receive a 30% reduced tuition rate at Clarkson College. Applicants receive automatic acceptance into all online programs and preferential status for all on-campus programs. Team members are also eligible for academic scholarships and financial aid.

Service Contract Members who meet the eligibility criteria will have access to a variety of continuing education (CE) events that are approved by the American Society of Radiologic Technologists (ASRT). Annually, BMI will choose Service Contract Members who will receive free registration (up to 70 seats) to CE events.

- > New applicants should visit ClarksonCollege.edu/Apply to begin the application. When complete, use the code BMI@Clarkson to waive the \$35 application fee.
- Current Clarkson College students who work at a facility that is contracted with BMI should submit the completed Community Partnership Verification Form to the imaging department director for verification of employment. You must then submit the form to the BMI human resources (HR) department for service contract verification.
- > Every semester, BMI team members must complete the following:
 - Print off the Community Partnership Verification Form (available online at ClarksonCollege.edu/Browns-Medical-Imaging or through the BMI HR office).
 - 2. Complete the form and meet with the BMI HR representative manager to obtain his/her signature.
 - 3. The student will email the form to HR for service contract verification.
 - 4. BMI HR representative/manager will submit the form to the Clarkson College Student Accounts office at studentaccounts@clarksoncollege.edu.
- Students are responsible for payment of tuition and fees to Clarkson College by the tuition payment due date. Failure to comply may result in late payment fees.
