Job duties include: development and maintenance of the organizations databases for ensuring data integrity and security and coordination and development of report and query requests for information contained in the organization's databases. Specific duties will include:

- Serving as the primary writer for all requested reports related to data contained in the organization's databases, which includes:
 - coordinating, developing, and managing reports and queries for data contained in databases;
 - Providing support for all requests for data from the databases; and
 - Providing customer service by reviewing reports for accuracy and usefulness;

- Providing support for student information systems software, which includes:
 - Maintaining an understanding of student information software functions;
 - Providing student information system software training as needed;
 - Troubleshooting user problems utilizing vendor resources to resolved when needed;
 - Implementing upgrades and activating new functions utilizing pre-testing and follow-up with end users after utilization; and
 - Creating and maintaining written procedures and documentation for student information system operations.
