Scholarship Specific Requirements:

- Must be a <u>new</u> student at Clarkson College enrolled in an associate or bachelor's degree program.
- Must be a first-generation student. For this scholarship, first-generation is defined as an individual
 whose parents did not complete a baccalaureate degree or who resided with and received support
 from only one parent who did not complete a baccalaureate degree.
- Exceptional academic achievement demonstrated with a 3.0 high school GPA or higher or college transfer GPA or higher. The GPA used will be the GPA from the student's acceptance to the college.
- Must have demonstrated financial need (determined by current FASFA).
- Demonstrates values of compassion and caring through service to others. Applicants must submit a list of service hours completed and one contact person to verify hours if needed.
- Must list involvement in extracurricular activities, honor societies, professional organizations, etc.
- Demonstrated leadership through involvement in multiple school, workplace, and/or community activities. List years of contribution and leadership positions held.
- Applicants must provide two letters of recommendation of their choice.
- Complete a 500-word essay that is typed, double-spaced, with a 12-point font in Times New Roman.
 - o A brief introduction of who you are to the selection committee.
 - A brief reflection on how you have demonstrated values of compassion and caring through service to others (i.e., community and volunteer work, work/life experience, etc.).
 - A brief description of the challenges you have faced as a first-generation student and how you plan to impact your community positively as a healthcare professional.
- Recipients are required to attend <u>two (2) mentor</u> appointments with a designated faculty member and a minimum of <u>one (1) activity or group meeting</u> each enrolled semester.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA and remain in good academic and behavioral standing to continue receiving the scholarship.
- Students may be enrolled either full or part-time; however, the annual scholarship amount is awarded based on academic year and cannot exceed four (4) years.
