

Mid-Plains Community College Articulation Agreement with Clarkson College



Associate of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant

Effective Fall 2025



Clarkson College has a signed articulation agreement with Mid-Plains Community College (MPCC).

By completing an Associate's degree, or at least 35 credit hours from Mid-Plains Community College, including the 14 credit hours of prerequisite courses listed below, students are eligible to complete the [hybrid Associate of Science in PTA Transfer](#) track at Clarkson College. Throughout the consecutive 16 month-program (4 semesters) at Clarkson College, Transfer PTA students complete three semesters of asynchronous distance education courses with four on-campus skills weekends per semester, followed by one semester of final clinical experiences.

Students must have the following courses from Mid-Plains Community College with a transfer grade of a "C" or higher completed: Human Anatomy with lab (4), Human Physiology with lab (4), English Composition I (3), Medical Terminology (1), Introduction to Psychology (3). The following degree plan outlines the courses needed to complete the Associate of Science in Physical Therapist Assistant degree.
