

Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Metropolitan Community College. The transfer guide shows how courses completed at Metropolitan Community College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of "C-" or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

All courses are offered at Clarkson College and not necessary for admission.
