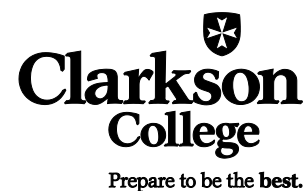

Clarkson College accepts transfer credit from Western Nebraska Community College. The transfer guide shows how courses completed at Western Nebraska Community College will be transferred to Clarkson College. It is important for students transferring credit to Clarkson College to submit a final official transcript after completing all course work from other institutions. Students must receive a grade of “C-” or higher to be considered for transfer credit. Clarkson College does not accept transfer credit for courses taken after enrollment at Clarkson College.

**All courses are offered at Clarkson College and not necessary for admission.**

Students who have their RN and are accepted into our RN-BSN or RN-MSN program will receive 79 Direct Transfer Credits for their licensure, which will cover all general education courses except ST 310 Statistics (can be transferred in) and HC 206 Pathophysiology and Pharmacology: Current Practices (must be taken at Clarkson College).

**Elective Credit**

Traditional BSN program: An additional eight credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

LPN-BSN program: An additional seven credit hours may be transferred in as elective credit to Clarkson College.

**Residency Requirement** At least 27 semester hours must be completed at Clarkson College for a bachelor's degree.
